

基礎適性検査問題・英語（解答番号 21～30）

1 以下の文中の空欄に入る英文として最も適切なものを次の①～④のうちから選びなさい。

(1) A : Excuse me. Is Mr. Yamada here in the teachers' room now?

B : Sorry, he's out now. 21

A : No thanks. I just need to give him my math homework.

B : I'll put it on his desk, then.

- ① Can you call him back later?
- ② Do you want to leave a message?
- ③ Are you a student in Mr. Yamada's class?
- ④ Do you have any homework?

(2) A : Who is that on TV?

B : He's the president of the United States of America!

A : Obviously, I know the president! 22

B : Oh, I don't know. I've never seen that man.

- ① I'm surprised he's still around.
- ② Who is standing next to him?
- ③ Is he in Japan right now?
- ④ He gave a big speech a few days ago, right?

(3) A : Is the music festival held next weekend, Beth?

B : Yes, Mike. Have you bought the ticket? I bought mine online last night.

A : Not yet. I just want to make sure I don't have any other plans.

B : 23 According to the website, not too many tickets are remaining.

- ① I haven't checked their website yet.
- ② There should be plenty of tickets still available.
- ③ We can always go next time instead.
- ④ You should decide quickly.

- (4) *A* : Have you ever been to that restaurant before?
B : You know ... I've lived here my whole life but I've never been there.
A : Wow. That's hard to believe.
B : Tourists love it, but the locals don't think about it much.
- ① They never have to go there, then.
 - ② I can accept that.
 - ③ It seems like such a popular spot.
 - ④ Their food was not as delicious as you said.
- (5) *A* : Whose umbrella is this?
B : It's not mine. I thought it was yours.
A :
B : Well, that means someone left it here in the café.
- ① It isn't mine either.
 - ② You're totally right.
 - ③ Oh, it's mine. Thanks.
 - ④ You can use mine if you like.
- (6) *A* : Hmm ... the flowers in the pot don't look good.
B : They're turning brown. Did you give them enough water?
A : Of course. They get enough light from that window, too.
B : Did you know that wind is also important? Why don't you ?
- ① close the curtain sometimes and cut the sunlight
 - ② open the window sometimes and let fresh air come in
 - ③ stop watering for a while and let the soil dry
 - ④ clean the leaves and get rid of small insects

- 2 次の対話文の空欄に入れるのに最も適切なものを、下の①～⑤から1つずつ選び、記号で答えなさい。ただし、同じ選択肢を2度以上使わないこと。

Emily: I'm trying to write a **haiku*, but I can't think of a good ending.

Taiga: I don't know much about *haiku*, but I'll take a look at it. 27

Emily: Thanks. Here's what I wrote: "Winter has ended, yet my heart still feels so cold." 28

Taiga: How about "Loving you begins the summer"?

Emily: That's way too many *syllables. The ending part needs to be five syllables, not five words. 29 It is one word but two syllables. Got it?

Taiga: Ah, got it. But I guess we should ask Matsuo. He's the best writer at school. Hey, Matsuo! Can you help us out real quick?

Matsuo walks up and looks at Emily's paper.

Matsuo: "Refrigerator."

Matsuo walks away.

Emily: What? I don't understand. 30 "Winter has ended, yet my heart still feels so cold," No way, it's perfect!

Taiga: He certainly is a great writer, huh?
