1 以下の文中の空欄に入る英文として最も適切なものを次の①～④のうちから選びなさい。

(1) A : Pete, why did you do so poorly on your math test?

B : This time I didn't have enough time to study, Dad.

A : 21

B : Well, I guess I was too busy practicing basketball.

① Who is your math teacher?

② How do you do?

③ What was the result?

④ Why didn't you?

(2) A : That old woman over there is walking three bulldogs.

B : They are so big! 22

A : I know, right? If one of them started running, she would fly.

B : Yeah, but that probably won't happen because they are all walking quietly.

① I wonder how she can handle them.

② But they look more like cats.

③ They don't seem to be well-trained.

④ Look how fast they are running.

(3) A : Welcome to Marie's Café. Are you ready to order?

B : Can I have a large tea?

A : Would you like lemon or sugar with that?

B : 23

A : Sure. One L-sized sweet lemon tea coming up.

① Just lemon, please. I want it bitter.

② Could you make that a size L?

③ Could I have both?

④ Actually, give me one more tea, please.

(4) *A* : Hey, the announcement says “The train will be arriving soon.”

B : I know, but I’m going to get a photo of it pulling in.

A : Didn’t you hear them? It’s dangerous. 24

B : OK, OK. I will.

- ① Get closer to take a perfect shot.
- ② Take a step back for your safety.
- ③ I believe it’s pretty crowded.
- ④ I hope I can take a seat.

(5) *A* : How can I improve my speaking skills?

B : Here’s a simple yet effective tip. Smile while you talk.

A : Eh, I’d rather not do that.

B : Trust me. 25

- ① Nobody would do that.
- ② I can’t agree with you more.
- ③ It will make you sound much better.
- ④ Keeping silent is sometimes the best option.

(6) *A* : I see crows over there.

B : Argh, crows. I hate them! Always getting into our garbage and making a mess.

A : 26 People in your apartment keep leaving their garbage out.

B : I disagree. We would be much better off without any crows.

- ① It’s not the crows’ fault.
- ② Actually, I don’t like crows either.
- ③ I don’t blame people for doing it.
- ④ I’m always surprised how calm they are.
